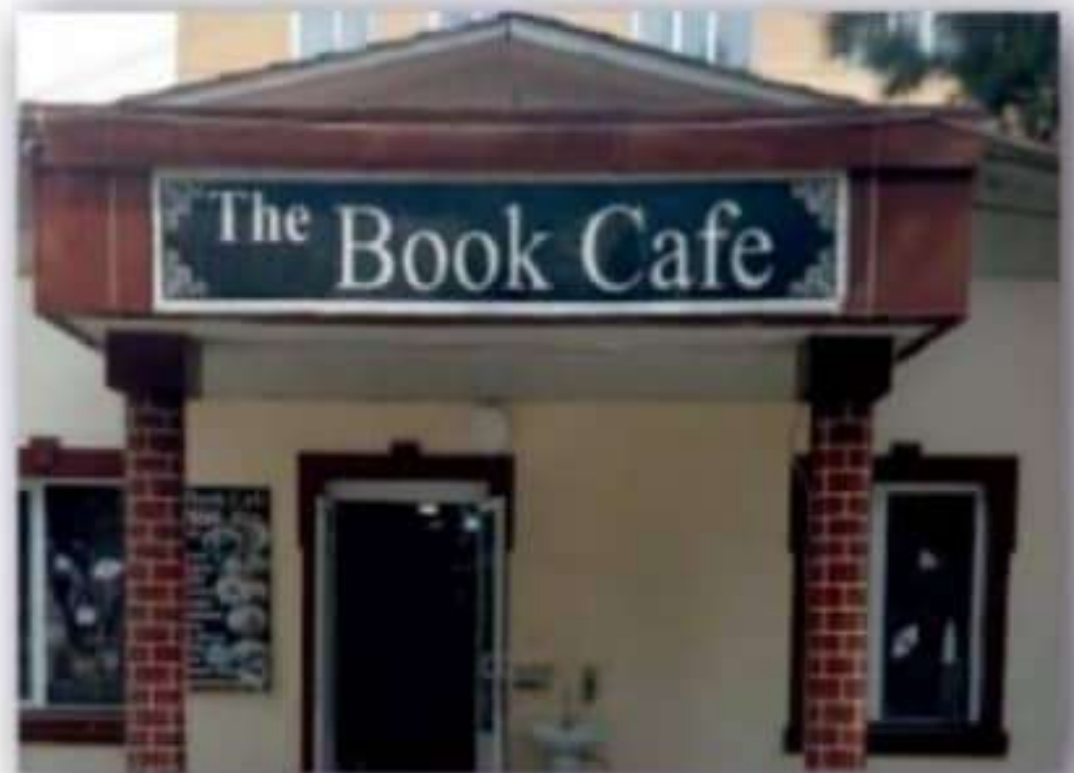

HOW TO REACH

- ✦ **Flights:** Fly directly to Tashkent (Islam Karimov International Airport) with **Uzbekistan Airways** from major Indian cities, or choose one-stop connections
- ✦ **In-country transport:**
 - ✦ **Trains (Night / High-speed/ regular):** Tashkent ↔ Samarkand ↔ Bukhara etc.
 - ✦ **Shared taxis / "marshrutkas":** Frequent between cities (when full) - common in Uzbek travel.
 - ✦ **Domestic flights:** Uzbekistan Airways connects e.g. Tashkent → Nukus / Urgench / Bukhara etc.
 - ✦ **Car + driver / self-drive:** Rentable, sometimes with large deposit, good for flexible Silk Road routes.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

- ✦ **March-May & September-November:** Pleasant, perfect for sightseeing and travel.
- ✦ **June-August & Winter:** Hot deserts; snow and skiing in Chimgan & Beldersay.

INSIDER TIPS FOR INDIANS

- ✦ Many Indian travellers **benefit from e-Visa / visa on arrival policies** (check current status)
- ✦ Russian / Uzbek language basics help in shared taxis; carry fare estimates
- ✦ **Photography:** In mosques / religious spaces, ask permission
- ✦ **Dress modestly** when entering religious sites
- ✦ **Cash & cards:** Have some cash (Uzbek sum) in smaller towns
- ✦ Use local transit apps (Yandex / local taxi apps) in big cities
- ✦ **Book trains / overnight sleepers early**
- ✦ **Local SIM / internet** on arrival for maps / ride-hailing
- ✦ **Cultural patience:** Uzbekistan moves at its own pace; take time to walk off beaten paths
- ✦ **Weather prep:** Pack layers - deserts get cold overnight
